

**SHERIFF GENE CARY REPORTS THE FOLLOWING
ONGOING ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR AND
NARRATIVE EXCERPTS FROM THE WEEK ENDING December 8, 2008**

12/2 Donna Nordstrom, Coon Valley, struck a legally parked vehicle owned by Eugene Groth, Coon Valley, on Central Avenue in the Village.

12/2 Loren Curtis, Ontario, lost control of her vehicle on County Road F, Town of Forest, and rolled her vehicle into the ditch. No injuries were reported.
