SHERIFF JOHN SPEARS REPORTS THE FOLLOWING ONGOING ACTIVITIES FOR THE YEAR AND NARRATIVE EXCERPTS FROM THE WEEK ENDING **November 28, 2011**

11/21 Shane Dvorjac, Oshkosh, lost control of his vehicle while driving on Beaver Creek Road, Town of Greenwood. He went through the intersection of County Road V, striking a power pole, but reported no injuries.
